Homework Club

What is the Homework Club?

After the children arrive from their respective schools they will get settled, have snack, and then have a meeting with the site coordinator. They will be told what activities are scheduled for the day and what choices they have. After meeting, Homework Club members will meet in the library, a classroom, or separate part of the cafeteria, depending on availability. If you sign them up, we will make every effort to have them attend Homework Club. Please make sure they understand this. The club meets Monday through Thursday for approximately 45 minutes or until your child finishes his/her homework, whichever comes first.

What to expect from Stoughton Extended Day.

This is not a one-on-one tutoring session. It is a quiet place for your children to complete their work. If they need some assistance, our staff will be there to help. The Stoughton elementary school teachers have asked us not to correct students' work for mistakes and neatness. They would like the corrections to be done in the classroom. The teachers need to see how well students understand the subject matter before continuing lessons and testing. Upon completion of their homework, we will look over their work to make sure it is completed. Your children will then be able to choose the activity they would like to attend.

What we usually hear

"I don't have any homework." "I finished it at school." "I would rather do it at home." "I forgot it at school." "I don't want to do it now."

Please keep this in mind when your children arrive home and their homework suddenly appears incomplete. We will make every effort to check their bags, ask other classmates, and motivate your child to complete their homework, but there is only so much we can do. If this is an ongoing issue, we will contact you to keep you informed. On the other side, please let us know if there is anything we can do differently to help your child.

How do I sign up?

Fill out the Homework Club form and pass it in to the site coordinator, or return it to the administrative office.
